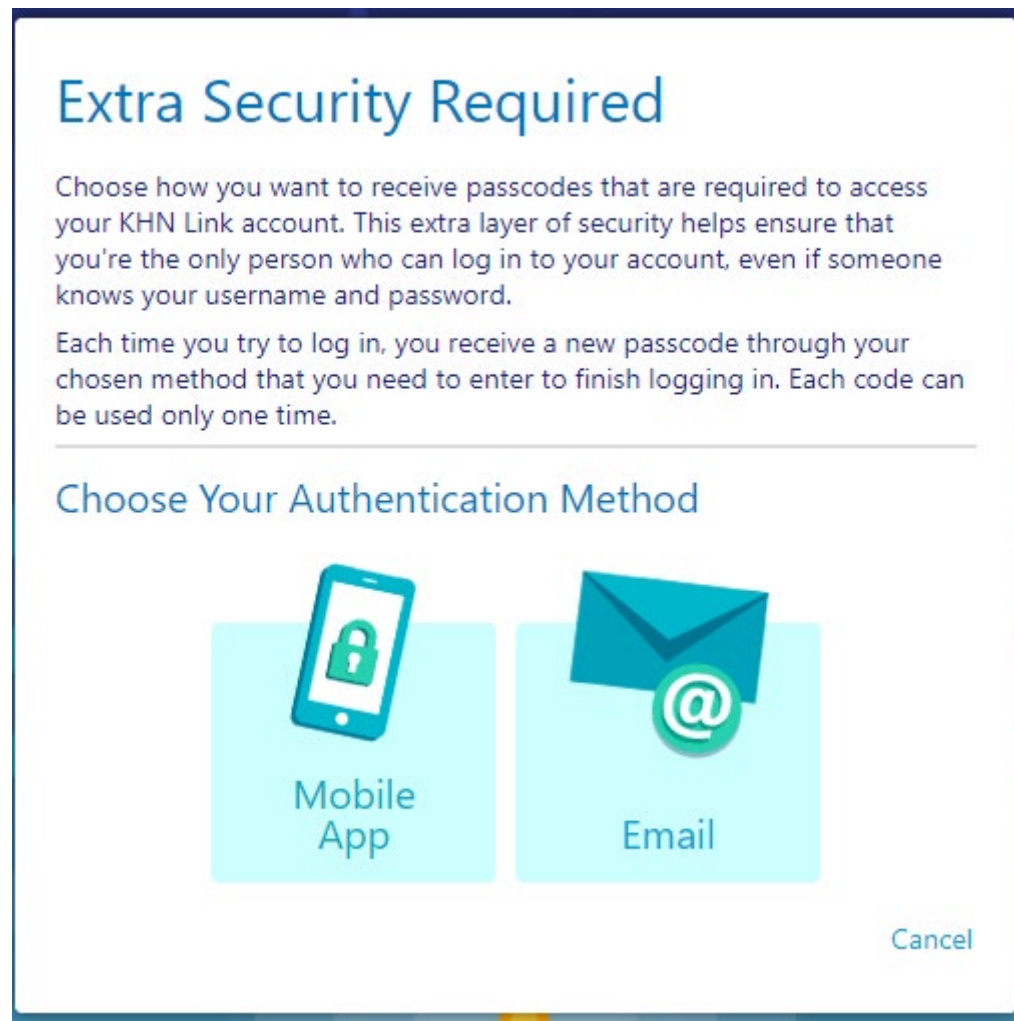



Set Up Two Factor Authentication (TFA) – EpicCare link users

When you log into Kettering Health EpicCare Link for the first time you are prompted to choose a method of receiving the randomly generated passcodes. You can choose to use email or the Microsoft Authenticator application on your mobile device. After you choose a method, on-screen prompts guide you through the rest of the set up.



Set up Authentication via Email

Enter the email address to receive passcodes.


