Kettering Health is fully operational with the Epic Electronic Medical Record, which includes E-Prescribing of all medications. Epic specialty training is required. It encompasses e-learning and virtual classes. Refresher training is required every two years. Classes are currently held via Microsoft Teams:

E-Prescribing Controlled Substance (EPCS) went live in December 2019 and will be mandated by the Federal Government by January 1, 2021. We have implemented a hands-free, second-sign push token technology that provides fast and automated authentication that meets Federal Requirements. To prepare:



- Download Imprivata ID from your smart phone's app store. Must be Android 7 or later or iOS 11 or later. Imprivata security codes will need to be enrolled to complete the process.
