This document is focused on defining qualifications related to competency to exercise clinical privileges. The applicant must also adhere to any additional organizational, regulatory, or accreditation requirements that the organization is obligated to meet.

Required Qualifications	
<b>Membership</b>	To be eligible to apply for core privileges in psychiatry, the initial applicant must meet the following criteria.
<b>Education/Training</b>	Completion of a residency/fellowship approved by Accreditation Council of Graduation Medical Education (ACGME), American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), or American Osteopathic Association (AOA) in psychiatry.
<b>Certification</b>	Current certification or active participation in the examination process, with achievement of certification within six years of completion of residency, leading to certification in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or the American Osteopathic Board of Neurology and Psychiatry.
<b>Clinical Experience (Initial)</b>	Applicants for initial appointment must be able to demonstrate the provision of inpatient, outpatient, or consultative services, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for at least 30 patients during the past 12 months, or demonstrate successful completion of an ACGME, ABMS or AOA-accredited residency, clinical fellowship, or research in a clinical setting within the past 12 months.
<b>Clinical Experience (Reappointment)</b>	To be eligible to renew core privileges in general psychiatry, the applicant must meet the following maintenance of privilege criteria: Current demonstrated competence and an adequate volume of experience with acceptable results, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for the past 24 months based on results of ongoing professional practice evaluation and outcomes. Evidence of current ability to perform privileges requested is required of all applicants for renewal of privileges.

## Core Privileges Psychiatry

**Description:** This list is a sampling of procedures included in the core. This is not intended to be an all-encompassing list but rather reflective of the categories/types of procedures included in the core.

			<b>- Currently granted privileges</b>
			Admit, evaluate, diagnose, treat, and provide consultation to adult patients, presenting with mental, behavioral, addictive or emotional disorders, e.g., psychoses, depression, anxiety disorders, substance abuse disorders, developmental disabilities, and adjustment disorders. Privileges include providing consultation with physicians in other fields regarding mental, behavioral, or emotional disorders; pharmacotherapy; psychotherapy; family therapy; behavior modification; consultation to the courts; and emergency psychiatry, as well as the ordering of diagnostic, laboratory tests, and prescribe medications. Includes the performance of history and physical exams. May provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in conformance with unit policies. Assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of patients with emergent conditions consistent with medical staff policy regarding emergency and consultative call services.

## Child and Adolescent Psychiatry

### Qualifications

#### Education/Training

To be eligible to apply for privileges in child and adolescent psychiatry, the initial applicant must meet the following criteria: The same as General Psychiatry plus successful completion of an accredited ACGME, ABMS or AOA fellowship in child and adolescent psychiatry or documented experience as evidenced by a letter from department chair or other appropriate designee.

#### Clinical Experience (Initial)

Applicants for initial appointment must be able to demonstrate the provision of inpatient, outpatient or consultative services, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for at least 15 patients during the past 12 months or demonstrate successful completion of an ACGME, ABMS or AOA accredited residency, clinical fellowship or research in a clinical setting within the past 12 months.

#### Clinical Experience (Reappointment)

To be eligible to renew core privileges in child and adolescent psychiatry, the applicant must meet the following maintenance of privilege criteria: Current demonstrated competence and an adequate volume of experience with acceptable results, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for the past 24 months based on results of ongoing professional practice evaluation and outcomes. Evidence of current ability to perform privileges requested is required of all applicants for renewal of privileges.

			<b>- Currently granted privileges</b>
			Admit, evaluate, diagnose, treat and provide consultation to children and adolescents, who suffer from mental, behavioral, addictive or emotional disorders. Privileges include being able to provide consultation with physicians in other fields regarding mental, behavioral or emotional disorders and their interaction with physical disorders. Includes the performance of history and physical exams. [May provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in conformance with unit policies.] Assess, stabilize and determine disposition of patients with emergent conditions consistent with medical staff policy regarding emergency and consultative call services.

**Addiction Medicine**

**Qualifications**

**Education/Training** Completion of a residency/fellowship approved by Accreditation Council of Graduation Medical Education (ACGME), American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), or American Osteopathic Association (AOA) in Internal Medicine or General Psychiatry and/or specialized training in Addiction Medicine AND/OR Current certification in Internal Medicine with specialized training in Addiction Medicine or subspecialty certification or active participation in the examination process, with achievement of certification within six years, leading to subspecialty certification in Addiction Psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or Certificate of Added Qualifications in Addiction Medicine by the American Osteopathic Board of Neurology and Psychiatry.

**Clinical Experience (Initial)** Applicants for initial appointment must be able to demonstrate the provision of inpatient, outpatient or consultative services, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for at least 15 patients during the past 12 months, or demonstrate successful completion of an ACGME, ABMS or AOA accredited residency, clinical fellowship or research in a clinical setting within the past 12 months.

**Clinical Experience (Reappointment)** To be eligible to renew core privileges in addiction medicine, the applicant must meet the following maintenance of privilege criteria: Current demonstrated competence and an adequate volume of experience with acceptable results, reflective of the scope of privileges requested, for the past 24 months based on results of ongoing professional practice evaluation and outcomes. Evidence of current ability to perform privileges requested is required of all applicants for renewal of privileges.

Includes performance of history and physical exam. May provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in conformance with unit policies. Assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of patients with emergent conditions consistent with medical staff policy regarding emergency and consultative call services.
