

Trauma Transfer Tip Sheet

- Patient Name and DOB
- Mechanism of Injury
- Physical Location (Room Number)
- Isolation Concerns: MRSA/VRE/C-DIFF or airborne/droplet precautions needed
- Patient's height/weight, current vital signs and GCS score
- Travel Considerations (Air vs Ground– is a helipad accessible)
- Equipment Needed (telemetry, oxygen, IV infusions, A-lines, chest tubes, etc...)

All **trauma patients** coming to any KHN facility are **automatically accepted** by the ED physician at the appropriate facility. We will facilitate a conference call between physicians and will arrange for transport. For hospitals >30 minutes away by ground we anticipate using air transport.
